

Four Single Days of Pleasure - Extend your stay and enjoy them all!

Santa Rosa and Sonoma Valley (just some suggestions)

- Enjoy Charles Schultz cartoons & life at his museum in Santa Rosa
- Wander the Luther Burbank gardens in the blooming seasons
- Visit 26 wineries using our complimentary Wine Passport
- Leave the car here and hike Annadel State Park or walk around Spring Lake
- Be adventurous, rent mountain bikes and cycle Annadel a top N Bay location
- Take a horse ride in one of the parks
- Tour Sonoma State Historic Park and Sonoma Plaza in downtown Sonoma
- Hike Mt Hood Regional Park or Jack London State Park (also visit his museum there) Just two more of our three great parks

Russian River tour

- Take River Road FROM Hwy 101 to Guerneville and Armstrong Redwood State Park
- The logging town of Duncan Mills has antiques and a great place for lunch
- Walk out on the mouth of the river estuary where the sand-banks host seals
- Head north to see Fort Ross, southern point reached by Russian trappers
- Head south to Bodega Bay made famous by Alfred Hitchcock's film "The Birds"
- Return after watching a west coast sunset at an ocean-side restaurant

Lake Sonoma tour

- Call in at Healdsburg
- Make your way north through Alexander Valley into Dry Creek appellation
- Stop to pick up picnic items at Dry Creek Store and continue to the scenic overlook above Lake Sonoma.
- Stop by the Fish Hatchery to see Steelhead salmon
- Return along West Dry Creek Road into the Russian River appellation and back by River Road OR take two hours touring to Stewarts Pt through stunning Sonoma back-country to the coast and return south by Jenner

Napa Valley tour

- Take the Calistoga Road $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of the inn, over the mountains to Calistoga, with a stop at the Petrified Forest on the way.
- Calistoga, famous for its warm water springs and mudbaths, indulge!
- Visit Napa wineries down to Oakville
- Eat in Yountville, St Helena or on the Wine Train (departs from Napa, booking required)
- Return over Oakville Grade or Spring Mountain Road (St Helena)

Melitta Station Inn is very central for each one of these itineraries
